- Has a passion for combining small scale vegetable and cut flower production to support food security/food justice local issues and education
- Managing daily operations, purchasing supplies, general landscaping, and some property maintenance of urban agriculture spaces
- Technical and practical competence to ensure soil health and overall crop production throughout the growing seasons
- Maintains attractive, productive, and ecologically friendly growing spaces
- Maintains site upkeep to support a safe experience for local youth, volunteers, and other visitors
- Willingness to joyfully work outside in all-weather conditions
- Exercises adaptability to changing situations, needs of program participants
- Open to learning new farming practices that align with Creation Care initiatives (planting natives, addressing pollinator needs/habitat/health, recycling, composting, etc)
- Schedule and harvest produce, all produce picked must be weighed, then packaged and stored appropriately
- Ability to create and follow yearly crop planting schedule, pending weather
